

The Season of Advent



## UPDATE ON CLOTHES FOR KIDS, KATHMANDU, NEPAL: First of all,

I would like to warmly thank everyone at Faith, London and Grace, Strathroy for so generously giving items of children's clothing for me to send to the children living in the tent city in Kathmandu. Many thanks also for the monetary gifts of \$380.00 which went a long way towards the shipping and handling fees incurred at the post office.

So far, three boxes have been sent off in care of our new friends, the Kumar family, and the first one was received the first week of November. This first shipment took approximately six weeks to arrive.

We received a phone call from Sanjay early on the morning of Nov 5th. He told us that the children were all very happy to receive the clothing, their parents were most thankful, and he himself was also thankful to be the person giving the gifts out! One lady in the tent city had just had a baby, and so found the infant items to be most welcome. Sanjay put his 7 year old sister on the line, she gave the traditional "Namaste" greeting and in "newly-learned" English "Thank You Very Much"!

Here is a list of the items that have been sent to Nepal to date - I tried to send a mixture of infants', boys' and girls' items of varying sizes in each shipment:
